our nature:

(through 'The Moral Fall': the self-exaltation & death of humanity)

- rebel children
- rebel creatures
- rebel servants (worshippers, rulers, stewards)

now lifelessly & restlessly enslaved to unrighteousness—being:

1) OUT OF FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD

our mind darkened, & heart guiltily & defensively hardened, having:

* a deadening, inner thrust of hostility towards Him always choosing to refuse His holy presence, with a dark spirit of:

- disregard

('He is nothing to me')

- unbelief

('His word is nothing to me')

- ingratitude

(He has done nothing for me')

- defiance

('His will, way & pleasure mean nothing to me')

2) <u>DISHONOURING TO GOD</u>

still capable of so much that's grand, yet refusing His face there is:

* a horrible mis-representation of Him

through the accursed intrusion into our humanity of:

- unholy affections

(in our inner being a polluted spring of moral impurity: strong, idolatrous passion for the stimulation of sensory experience, the possession of magnificent things & the elevation of personal status; which is also then within us a polluted spring of relational idolatry: falsely focused, fallen-human love that incessantly looks to people, situations & things, grasping for what is not received from above—all making our heart more corrupt & self-serving than we realize)

- non-truth

(in our thinking a worldview that sees God, humanity & the creation in a way that best promises to fulfill our passions)

- foolishness & futility

(in our daily, relational living much nobility, but corruption in all we desire, think, say & do—nothing of eternal worth)
